Clubhouse: The clubhouse is located in the southwest corner of the Marina de La Paz facility. Drinking alcohol at the clubhouse is not allowed except during specific clubsponsored events. Pets must be on a leash and there is no smoking.

VHF: A VHF radio net is hosted by the club on channel 22A at 8:00 am Monday thru Saturday. Outside of the clubhouse, there is a VHF radio available for public use.

Incoming Mail: Marina de La Paz receives mail and packages for the fleet. They announce mail on the morning VHF net the day after it is received. Address incoming postal mail and packages to:

There is a per diem charge if not picked up right away. Letters are \$20 pesos per day and packages range from \$50 – \$300 pesos per day depending on size.

Outgoing Mail: The club facilitates mail delivery to the USPS through members that volunteer to carry it up. It must be flat mail and include the proper amount of US postage. There is an outgoing US mail slot at the Clubhouse.

Video Lending: The DVD lending library is for members only. DVDs may be checked out during coffee hour and returned at any time via the slot on the inside door to the back room.

Book Exchange: The book exchange in the clubhouse is open to all cruisers.

Coffee Hour: Join us for coffee hour from 9:30 to 10:30 Monday through Saturday mornings at the clubhouse. Coffee or tea is a mere 10 pesos per cup.

Bulletin Boards: Located outside the clubhouse the bulletin boards have information on club notices and events, items for sale or trade, services in La Paz, crew and lots more.
