### **MINUTES**

CALL TO ORDER: By Heidi Benson Stagg, Vice Commodore at 4:00pm

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** Pat presented the December 2023 Financial Report. The Club's charity fund is doing well at \$80,000 pesos. The general fund is lower than we would like at \$61,943 pesos. If the Club continues to have lower than usual memberships without bringing in additional income while paying regular monthly expenses of cleaning, website and coffee supplies, the general fund will run out of funds in May 2024. An extensive discussion ensued among the Board and members on possible ways to avoid or cushion such a serious financial setback, which initiated a motion.

Motion to rescind the motion passed at the November 21, 2023, meeting to designate all proceeds from the pancake breakfasts to the charity fund. – Teri; Second – Tom; All Ayes This decision is meant to ensure the Club's solvency and will be relied on only if necessary.
